- CROP** - Went over current status- obtaining pictures, public outreach as well as other materials to have steps 1-4 completed. Will send out information to committee once it's further along.
- Organics Bill** - The draft version of the organics ordinance was completed and sent to the SWAC members for review and comment. Richard will be taking it to the Commission for review and approval. The question was asked if the legal counsel has reviewed the ordinance. It was not known at the time of the meeting whether it has been sent to the legal counsel for review. Kevin noted that Richard is the lead on this item, and he was not in attendance for today's meeting and that the draft ordinance was created using a version obtained from Thurston County.
- The SWAC members provided feedback on the Ordinance and a suggestion was made to add this Ordinance as an addendum to the Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP), once approved by the County Commission, and then once appropriate, incorporate it in to the SWMP. The Ordinance will be brought back at the next meeting for further discussion.
