



- APPROACH SHALL NORMALLY BE AT 90 DEGREES TO ROAD CENTERLINE, BUT CAN VARY FROM 75 TO 105 DEGREES.
- 4. CULVERT PIPE MUST BE CONCRETE, CMP, OR CPEP WITH QUARRY SPALLS. MINIMUM LENGTH IS 20' OR DETERMINED BY THE WIDTH OF APPROACH PLUS 5' EACH END (EXCLUDING BEVELED ENDS).




RURAL RESIDENTIAL/MAJOR APPROACH DETAIL
