

Work performed throughout the quarter:

Task 1 – Project Administration and Management

Task 2- Shoreline Survey/Water Quality Monitoring

- Comments were received on the draft QAPP from the Department on 3/29/10.
- MCPH was directed by DOE to change labs from UW Marine Chemistry Lab to TWISS Analytical Lab.
- MCPH updated all portions of the QAPP to reference the appropriate lab.
- MCPH sent the QAPP with changes back to the Department on 5/12/10.
- MCPH received additional comments from the Department on 5/26/10, however staff was out of the office between 5/26/10 until 6/15/10.
- MCPH responded on 6/15/10 that the additional requirements had already been included in the changes in the QAPP.
- On 6/21/10, the Department made a new comment. MCPH did not make any changes after discussing the matter with the Department.
- The Department approved the QAPP on 6/24/10.
- MCPH performed monitoring on 6/24 and 6/25, covering approximately 3 miles of shoreline and obtaining about 30 samples.

Task 3- Septic System Surveys

• MCPH inspected two sites along the shoreline. One site was posted for non-occupancy due to a failing OSS. The other site has a grey water discharge and the owner still needs to be notified.

- MCPH provided On-site Septic System information and Operation and Maintenance Information at the Hood Canal Health Fair, sponsored by the Skokomish Tribe at the Hood Canal School on 6/18/10.
