

RESOLUTION NO. 100
NONDEBATABLE EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Chapter 6, Laws of 1970 Extraordinary Session, implementing the Law Enforcement & Fire Fighter's Retirement Act does make it mandatory for Counties to pay all medical and hospital bills for County employees falling under the Act, which are not taken care of by means of any other insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received hospital bills in amount \$151.60 for hospitalization and medical expenses for W. F. Anderson, who at the time of his death was Mason County Sheriff, and was covered by said Act; and

WHEREAS, it is reasonable to expect that Mason County will in the future be confronted with additional medical and hospital bills covered by the Law Enforcement & Fire Fighter's Retirement Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that a nondebatale emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that a fund may be established from which to pay such aforementioned bills, and it is HEREBY ORDERED that the 1970 Budget be prepared and \$500.00 be transferred into said fund, to be utilized for this express purpose.
