

RESOLUTION NO. 118

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Game is again setting up the Sandhill Pheasant Hunting Area in Northern Mason County; and

WHEREAS, they have requested permission of the Board of County Commissioners to again post the State Game Department's "No Parking At Any Time" signs along the Sandhill Road, which is a Mason County road, stating that the gravel pit off the road will be provided for parking area for the hunters; and

WHEREAS, they also requested that the Mason County Sheriff and his Deputies be authorized to enforce the no parking signs;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that permission be granted to the State Department of Game to post the Sandhill Road with their "No Parking At Any Time" signs, from the gravel pit Easterly to Stringer Creek, from October 10, 1970 through January 3, 1971, and that the Mason County' Sheriff and his Deputies be authorized to enforce the signs.
