

RESOLUTION NO. 120
NONDEBATABLE EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries has made it mandatory that certain corrections and repairs be made to the elevator in the Mason County Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners did request an estimate of the cost of the ordered corrections and repairs from Western Elevator Corporation, a Seattle firm with whom the County contracts the elevator maintenance; and

WHEREAS, said estimate has been received, and will cost \$1,185.00 plus Washington State Sales tax in amount \$59.05, making a total of \$1,244.05; and

WHEREAS, there is no money in the current budget to cover this amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that a nondebtable emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that the mandate be met, and it is HEREBY ORDERED that the 1970 General Administration Budget be extended and that \$1,244.05 be transferred from the Current Expense Fund into the General Administration Budget, to be utilized for this express purpose.
