

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1970, in conformance with RCW 36.81.010, the Board of County Commissioners entered upon their minutes a motion declaring their intention to establish a road to be known as the Haskel Hill Road #3861, the road would connect and be a continuation of the existing Haskel Hill Road.

The centerline of this road being more specifically described as follows:

That part of Government Lots 3 & 4 of Section 26, Township 21 North, Range 2 West, W. M., 60 feet in width, the Centerline thereof being described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north line of the Wilson County Road 298.45 feet West of the Southwest corner of a tract of land heretofore conveyed to Hildur Ashby and Charles W. Ashby by Warranty Deed dated March 27, 1967 and recorded under Auditor's file number 225018 records of Mason County, thence N. 55° 31' W. 581.75 feet and N 68° 39' 30" E 700 feet to the Westerly line of a tract of land heretofore conveyed to Fred Kronquist by Warranty deed dated May 27, 1942 and recorded under Auditor's file number 102314.

EXCEPT: The southerly 30 feet of the N. E. 10.73 feet thereof. All contained in Section 26, Township 21 North, Range 2 West, W. M., Mason County, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the proposed County Road is a public necessity, and that the County Engineer be directed to report thereon, and that the Clerk of the Board shall fix a time and place for hearing the report as required by statute, and that the Prosecuting Attorney be requested to review and give approval to the steps herein ordered.
