

RESOLUTION NO. 128

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on October 19, 1970, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which there was insufficient Budget for the County Auditor and County Treasurer for 1970; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sums will be required to meet them:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND

COUNTY TREASURER ----- \$900.00 to purchase a Check Protector  
COUNTY AUDITOR ----- \$900.00 to purchase a Check Protector.  
(Both amounts to include freight and State sales tax.)

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extensions be held at 11:30 A. M., Monday, November 2, 1970, at a regular session of the Board, at the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of such Budget Extensions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board a budget extension in amount \$900.00 must be appropriated for the County Auditor and a budget extension in the same amount must be appropriated for the County Treasurer, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
