

RESOLUTION NO. 63

WHEREAS, on December 8, 1969, the Board did have prepared and published, a Notice of Hearing on their intention to re-name a County Road, said Hearing being scheduled for 2:30 P. M., Monday, December 29, 1969, in the Commissioner's Office in the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, on changing the name of the "Delmore Road" to the "Sand Hill Road", as a result of request received from the North Mason Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, said Hearing was held at the above mentioned time and place and people appeared to express their opinion both for and against the name change; and

WHEREAS, said Hearing was continued until the same time on January 5, 1970, to give the Board a chance to weigh the pros and cons of the matter, at which time no one appeared to speak either for or against the proposed name change;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD in regular session, that the name of the "Delmore Road" be officially changed to the "Sand Hill Road", and the County Engineer be directed to so post.
