

RESOLUTION NO. 63-C

Naming the Roads in Replat of Tract A, Pirate's Cove No. 2 as shown on Page 107, Volume 5 of Plat Maps.

WHEREAS, on Monday, December 22, 1969, the Board of County Commissioners did receive a request from the County Engineer for the establishment of names of the following roads within said Plat:

- County Road No. 6374 to be named Treasure Lane
- County Road No. 6383 to be named Bahama Drive
- County Road No. 6385 to be named Barbary Drive
- County Road No. 6387 to be named Treasure Place
- County Road No. 6389 to be named Treasure Court
- County Road No. 6393 to be named Pirates Drive; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the County Engineer, ^{and after public hearing thereon} these road name adoptions are considered to be essential to conform with the arrangement and function of said roads in accordance with the latest log of Mason County roads performed jointly by Mason County and the Washington State Highway Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above named roads be named and hereinafter referred to as set out above.
