

RESOLUTION NO. 63-D

Naming a Portion of the Roads in the Plats of Lake Limerick Division #3, 4 and 5, as shown on Volume 6, Pages 126, 191, 192 and Volume 7, Page 18 of Plat Maps.

WHEREAS, on Monday, December 22, 1969, the Board of County Commissioners did receive a request from the County Engineer for the establishment of names of the following roads within said plats.

County Road No. 5332 to be named Olde Lyme Court

County Road No. 5338 to be named Olde Lyme Place

County Road No. 5408 to be named Sealford Court

County Road No. 5699 to be named Limerick Road, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the County Engineer, <sup>and after public hearing thereon</sup> these road name adoptions are considered to be essential to conform with the arrangement and function of said roads in accordance with the latest log of Mason County roads performed jointly by Mason County and the Washington State Highway Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above named roads be named, and hereinafter referred to as set out above.
