

RESOLUTION NO. 66

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, Washington does recognize the Cumulative Reserve Fund to be a solvent fund of the County; and

WHEREAS, expenses have arisen for which there is insufficient money in said fund for payment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED by the Board in session that the County Treasurer be hereby directed to transfer the sum of \$2,416.13 from the Cumulative Reserve Investment Fund to the Cumulative Reserve Fund; and

FURTHER, that the County Auditor be hereby directed to prepare a budget extension to the Cumulative Reserve Fund, in amount \$1,354.87, to cover 1969 budget expenditures relating to the replacement of the Court House furnace.
