

A RESOLUTION - adopting the Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of Washington, being Chapter 189 of the Session Laws of 1937 and amendments and additions thereto, by reference, as provided by RCW 36.32.120, and repealing all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict therewith.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of Washington, being Chapter 189 of the Session Laws of 1937, and all amendments and additions thereto, are hereby adopted by reference as the Motor Vehicle Laws of the County of Mason, and all amendments or additions thereto when printed and filed with the County Auditor, shall be considered and accepted as additions thereto without the necessity of further adoption of such amendments or additions.

SECTION 2. All Resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, morals, peace and safety of the people of Mason County and that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and the provisions of this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately without any other or further hearing hereon.
