## RESOLUTION # 83

WHEREAS, in the interest of safety and in conformance with procedures adopted by the Washington State Association of Counties, Mason County makes periodic inspections of bridges on the County road system; and

WHEREAS, several existing bridges in Mason County are constructed in whole or in part of untreated timber and are planned for revetment or replacement; and

WHEREAS, recent inspection and evaluation by the County Engineer reveal that certain bridges have deteriorated to such an extent that they cannot be certified as safe for all legal highway loads;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that gross loads on certain bridges be limited as set forth in the following table until December 31, 1971 unless this Board shall by appropriate action based upon proper certification modify or remove such restrictions:
