

RESOLUTION NO. 87

WHEREAS, at the time the 1970 County Budgets were set up and approved, Capital Outlay Items considered were listed under each separate office, but the funds to pay for such Capital Outlay Items were to come from the Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund; and

WHEREAS, not all these items are purchased at the same time, and funds for all these items are not available all at the same time.

NOW THEREFORE, be it HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Auditor shall be authorized to request a transfer of funds from the Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund to the Current Expense Fund on a quarterly basis, in such amount as may be necessary to cover the Capital Outlay Items purchased by all offices during that quarter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Treasurer be hereby directed to transfer the amount of \$2,260.36 from the Cumulative Reserve No. 2 Fund to the Current Expense Fund, to cover Capital Outlay purchases made during the first quarter of 1970.
