

RESOLUTION NO. 98

WHEREAS, RCW 29.45.120 states that the election officers shall be paid not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$1.50 per hour for the full time each is employed, with the exact amount to be fixed by the Board of County Commissioners of each county; with two hours compensation being paid to the Inspectors, and extra compensation being paid to the officer picking up and returning the election supplies; and

WHEREAS, Mason County has been paying their election boards at the rate of \$1.25 per hour, and it has become necessary to raise this amount in order to get competent and qualified election officers to serve on the election boards;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordered by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the County Auditor be hereby authorized to raise the pay of election officers to \$1.50 per hour, that the inspector of each Board be paid two hours extra compensation, and the officer picking up and returning the election supplies be paid mileage at the rate of 10¢ per mile traveled in doing so.
