

RESOLUTION NO. 145

WHEREAS, unforeseen and undebatable emergencies have arisen in the following Current Expense Fund Budgets for which insufficient funds are available; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for such expenditures as follows:

IT IS HEREBY UNANIMOUSLY ORDERED by the Board in session that the total amount of \$8,613.83 be ordered and authorized to provide the necessary funds to cover the above emergencies, in accordance with RCW 36.40.180.
