

RESOLUTION NO. 152
ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on February 22, 1971, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which there was insufficient budget for 1971; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interests of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ----- \$3,326.00 as final payment to Book Publishing Company for 25 copies of the Mason County Code.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 2:00 P. M., Monday, March 8, 1971, at a regular session of the Board, at the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of such Budget Extension:

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board a budget extension in amount \$3,326.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
