

MASON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 154

REGULATING UTILITIES ON ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY

AN ORDINANCE by the Board of Commissioners of Mason County, hereinafter called the Board, adopting regulations to govern the placing of facilities on Mason County rights-of-way and platted areas where right-of-way will be dedicated to the County.

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for FAS matching funds it is necessary for Mason County to adopt a policy for the accomodation of utilities on the rights-of-way along the designated routes, and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has presented to the Board of County Commissioners for its consideration and approval, "Policy on Accommodation of Utilities on Highway Rights of Way", as adopted by the Washington State Highway Commission Rasolution No. 2224, on June 15, 1970, effective on July 20, 1970;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY the the "Policy on Accommodation of Utilities on Highway Rights-of-Way", as adopted by Washington State Highway Commission Resolution No. 2224 be and the same is hereby ADOPTED to apply to the designated FAS routes in Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon anticipated early adoption by the County Road Administration Board of a Washington Administrative Code consisting of a recommended policy for accommodation of utilities on road rights-of-way, it is the intention of the Board to consider the adoption of a utility accommodation policy appropriate to the existing Federal regulations, which policy would apply to all roads in Mason County.
