

RESOLUTION NO. 161

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, on May 24, 1971 in conformance with RCW 36.81.101, the Board of County Commissioners entered upon their minutes a motion declaring their intention to establish a road (unnamed), petitioned for and constructed to County standards by the citizens abutting said road in Section 22 and 27, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, W. M.

The centerline of said road being more specifically described as follows:

Starting at the SW corner of Section 22, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, W. M.; thence N 88°00'43" East, 1739.76'; thence S6°50'30" East, 201.59 feet to the centerline of County Road #1892 (Old Arcadia Road) which is the true point of beginning. Thence running N6°50'30" West 1335.28 feet, this point being the end of the proposed road. The right-of-way being thirty (30) feet on each side of the described centerline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the proposed County Road is a public necessity, and that the County Engineer be directed to report thereon, and that the Clerk of the Board shall fix a time and place for hearing the report as required by statute, and that the Prosecuting Attorney be requested to review and give approval to the steps herein ordered.
