

RESOLUTION NO. 174

WHEREAS, in accordance with House Bill No. 242, Chapter 124, 1st Ex. Session of 1971, which states that election officers shall be paid not less than the state minimum wage rate of \$1.60 per hour, with the exact amount to be fixed by the Board of County Commissioners of each county; with two hours compensation being paid to the Inspectors, and extra compensation being paid to the officer picking up and returning the election supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Board's Resolution No. 98, adopted June 8, 1970 shall hereby be amended from the present \$1.50 per hour for said election board workers to meet the above-mentioned state law;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordered by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the County Auditor be hereby authorized to raise the pay of election officers to \$1.60 per hour, and that the inspector of each Board be paid two hours extra compensation, and the officer picking up and returning the election supplies be paid mileage at the rate of 10¢ per mile traveled in doing so.
