

R E S O L U T I O N No. 177

WHEREAS, County Road #3963 from M. P. 2.97 to its terminus at M. P. 4.23 is gravel surfaced and during hot, dry weather is rough and dusty; and

WHEREAS, the County does not have funds to apply a dust-free surface to this road at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Quadrant Corporation has under development Hartstone Pointe, a high-class recreational development beyond the terminus of the subject road; and

WHEREAS, the Quadrant Corporation is desirous of contributing the entire cost of the application of bituminous surface treatment to County Road #3963; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with their sales campaign, it is imperative that this work be done within the next three weeks; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists because of this situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners declare an emergency and does hereby authorize the County Engineer to negotiate with a responsible and competent contractor for the subject construction which will meet the approval of the Quadrant Corporation and which will be subject to the final approval of the Board.
