

RESOLUTION NO. 181

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE

PORTION OF SATSOP-CLOQUALLUM ROAD NO. 200
AND A PORTION OF THE PLUGMILL ROAD NO. 231

WHEREAS, the Satsop-Cloquallum Road was relocated in 1971, rendering a portion lying southerly of the existing location unused in Section 28, Township 19 North, Range 6 West, W. M.; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the County Engineer, the Board of County Commissioners hereby resolve that the following described portion of said Satsop-Cloquallum Road No. 200 and Plugmill Road #231 right-of-way be abandoned in accordance with RCW 36.87.010 and revert to the owners of the adjacent property:

That portion of the old Satsop-Cloquallum Road No. 200 located in the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 19 North, Range 6 West, W.M. beginning at Engineer's Station 2+68 through Engineer's Station 13+97; all lying south of a line thirty (30) feet south of the center line of the road as constructed in 1971 and as shown on the official map for this project on file in the office of the Mason County Engineer.

Also that portion of the Plugmill Road No 231 located in the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 19 North, Range 6 West, W.M. lying south of the southerly right-of-way line of the Satsop-Cloquallum Road as constructed in 1971, and as shown on the official map for this project on file in the office of the Mason County Engineer.

Situated in the County of Mason, State of Washington.

FURTHER, the Commissioners do hereby instruct the Clerk to prepare and publish a Notice of Hearing on said proposed abandonment; said Hearing to be held in the County Commissioners Office in the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington at ^{2:00 P.M.} ~~11:00 A.M.~~, Monday, September 20, 1971, and that the County Engineer be directed to submit a written report relative to the abandonment of the aforementioned portion of Satsop-Cloquallum Road No. 200.
