

RESOLUTION NO. 182

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on August 16, 1971, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which there was insufficient budget in the 1971 Cumulative Reserve No. 1 Fund; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

CUMULATIVE RESERVE FUND NO. 1 ----- \$32,000.00 for funds to purchase the Belfair Fire Hall.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 2:00 P. M., Monday, August 30, 1971, at a regular session of the Board, at the Courthouse at Shelton, Washington, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of such Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board a budget extension in amount \$32,000.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
