

RESOLUTION NO. 187  
EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, unforeseen emergencies have arisen in the following Current Expense Fund Budgets for which insufficient funds are available; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for such expenditures as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the above departments in the 1971 Current Expense Budget; and

IT IS HEREBY UNANIMOUSLY ORDERED by the Board in session that the total amount of \$1,154.90 be ordered and authorized to provide the necessary funds to cover the above emergencies, in accordance with RCW 36.40.180.
