RESOLUTION OF ESTABLISHMENT
-of-
COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of September, 1971, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish all the roads in the Plat of Highland Estates No. 1 and No. 2, Deeded to the County (under Auditor's Fee No. 263760); and

WHEREAS, after due Notice and public Hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report, maps, plans and specifications submitted by the Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that

"All the roads of the Plat of Highland Estates No. 1 and 2, EXCEPT the extension of Evergreen Drive from the westerly boundary of Division No. 1, and the cul-de-sacs off this extension"

be established as a part of the Mason County Road system, and the Mason County Engineer directed to proceed with said project according to the plans on file.

FURTHER: That all the above described roads be posted by the County Engineer with signs designating all such roads limited to a 25 Mile Per Hour speed limit.
