

RESOLUTION NO. 191

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners have been advised that the County Treasuerer has received the amount of \$213,919.23, which has been credited to the Federal Forest Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to allocate said funds for road and school purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Intermediate School District No. 113 Chairman has been requested to recommend the distribution of \$106,959.62 among the County School Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk has been instructed to request the transfer by the County Treasurer of \$106,959.61 of said funds to the County Road Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the said monies be distributed as above, and that the detail of the school distribution will be made at a future date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Treasurer be hereby directed to make above distribution of \$106,959.61 to the County Road Fund.
