

RESOLUTION NO. 192

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners were, on September 27, 1971, advised that the County Treasurer had received the amount of \$213,919.23, which had been credited to the Federal Forest Fund; and

WHEREAS, it was the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to allocate 50% of the Federal Forest Funds to Mason County School Districts and 50% to the Mason County Road Fund; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 1971, the Board did, by Resolution, direct the County Treasurer to transfer \$106,959.61 to the County Road Fund and to hold \$106,959.62 in the Suspense Fund until such time as their Resolution for distribution to the individual Schools was received;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the County Treasurer be hereby directed to make the following distribution of the \$106,959.62, presently being held in suspense, to the Mason County School District Funds as follows:
