

RESOLUTION NO. 208

WHEREAS, expenditures have arisen for which there are funds, but no budget from which to expend them in the Auditor's and Treasurer's 1971 Budgets; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is in the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures be provided for as follows:

Auditor - Capital Outlay for Check Protector - \$2,301.50
Treasurer - Capital Outlay for Check Protector - \$3,406.72
TOTAL ----- \$5,708.22

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that a budget extension in amount \$2,301.50 is necessary for the County Auditor's budget, and \$3,406.72 is necessary for the County Treasurer's budget, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED, to provide for these expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
