## AMENDMENT TO VACATION AND SICK LEAVE FOR NON-UNION COUNTY EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, a Resolution was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on February 4, 1957, wherein they established a uniform policy regarding annual vacation and sick leave for all non-union County employees, which Resolution may be found in Volume 12 of Commissioner's Journal, page 527; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution has since been amended on March 4, 1957, recorded in Commissioner's Journal 12, page 532; on January 1, 1964, recorded in Commissioner's Journal 13, page 612; and on November 9, 1970, recorded in Commissioner's Journal 16, page 50; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration the present Board of County Commissioners desire to make an Amendment to the original Resolution as follows:

That Section II be Amended to read as follows:

1. Four (4) years of employment ----- 13 days vacation. Eight (8) years of employment ----- 15 days vacation. Ten (10) years of employment ----- 16 days vacation. Thirteen years of employment ----- 18 days vacation. Fifteen (15) years of employment & after- 20 days vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the above Amendment be adopted, to become effective January 1, 1972, and that the Clerk of the Board be directed to prepare sufficient copies to be furnished to all payroll departments.
