RESOLUTION OF ESTABLISHMENT
-of-
COUNTY ROADS

(Tahuya River Valley, Divisions 1, 2 & 3)

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of December, 1971, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish "all and only those roads dedicated to the public on the face of the Plat of Tahuya River Valley, Divisions 1, 2 & 3, along with the Plat access road" as County Roads; and

WHEREAS, after due Notice and public Hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report submitted by the Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the above mentioned Plat roads be established as a part of the Mason County Road System, and the Mason County Engineer directed to proceed with said project according to the plans on file.
