

RESOLUTION OF ESTABLISHMENT  
-of-  
COUNTY ROADS

(Lynch Cove No. 2, 3 & 4)

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of September, 1970, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish "all the roads in the Plat of Lynch Cove No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4, dedicated to the public on the face of the Plats" as County Roads; and

WHEREAS, after due Notice and public Hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report submitted by the Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the above mentioned Plat roads be established as a part of the Mason County Road System, and the Mason County Engineer directed to proceed with said project according to the plans on file.
