

RESOLUTION NO. 228

PROPOSED FEDERAL AID SECONDARY PROJECT S-0595(1)

WHEREAS, the Federal Aid Secondary Route S-0595 (County Road #9750) was established by action of the Washington State Highway Department with approval of the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, as a means of relieving future increased traffic demands on the existing FAS Route S-0528, North Shore Road, and

WHEREAS, it is highly desirable that construction of the first increment in the planned development of the entire route be initiated promptly, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on February 14, 1972 with seven persons in attendance, at which time the principal design details of the proposed project FAS S-0595(1) were explained, and

WHEREAS, factors relating to the relationship of the proposed project with the general vicinity and with the entire route were made available for discussion, and

WHEREAS, no one present at the hearing nor any other by written communication interposed any objection to the proposed project plan nor to its programmed execution in 1972.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that FAS Project S-0595(1) is hereby declared to be a public necessity;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the acquisition of the remaining necessary right of way and the completion of plans, specifications and estimates and submittal thereof to the Washington State Highway Department for advertisement and bidding as early as practicable.
