

RESOLUTION NO. 235

ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSIONS

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on May 9, 1972, declaring that unforeseen expenditures had arisen for which there is insufficient budget for 1972 in the Sheriff's Capital Outlay; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND

Sheriff ----- Six 1972 automobiles ----- \$16,701.24

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 2:30 P. M., Monday, May 15, 1972, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$16,701.24 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
