

RESOLUTION NO. 242

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County Roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution adopted on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962 said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on a portion of Shelton-Matlock Road, County Road No. 9010, beginning easterly of the intersection of County Road #393, Nahwatzel Beach Drive and running southwesterly to the westerly side of County Road #375, Lake Nahwatzel Drive, warrant speed limits of 35 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that said portion of Shelton-Matlock Road, County Road #9010, be posted at 35 miles per hour and that the County Engineer be directed to erect the necessary 35 miles per hour signs in conformity herewith.
