

RESOLUTION NO. 243

WHEREAS, Chapter 77, Laws of 1972 Second Extraordinary Session provides that any town, city or county must contribute no less than two percent (2%) of its share of liquor taxes and profits to a program of treatment and rehabilitation for alcoholics; and

WHEREAS, Mason County has agreed to enter into a joint program with Thurston County through the Thurston-Mason Health District for this purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, Washington, that the Mason County Treasurer be directed to pay an estimated \$474.00 (or whatever dollar amount constitutes 2% of Mason County's actual liquor taxes and profits receipts from July 1, 1972 to December 31, 1972, to the Thurston-Mason Health District, as soon as such taxes and profits are received by him, to be utilized for this purpose.

WHEREAS, Chapter 77, Laws of 1972 2nd ex. sess. provides that any town, city or county must contribute no less than two percent (2%) of its share of liquor taxes and profits to a program of treatment and rehabilitation for alcoholics and,

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Thurston County has, under resolution No. 4356, directed the Thurston County auditor to establish a separate account within the Thurston-Mason Health District budget and,

WHEREAS, the Thurston-Mason Health District has agreed to administer this fund by entering into a contract with the Thurston-Mason Council on Alcoholism and

WHEREAS, the Thurston-Mason Mental Health and Mental Retardation Advisory Board has agreed to evaluate and oversee the appropriateness of planning,

THIS NOTICE IS THEREFORE GIVEN, that effective July 1, 1972 an amount of money is due the above established fund from each individual government unit named herein. In the following table the contribution is calculated for a six (6) month period. Funds should be paid as soon as received and shall not be paid to the contracting service agency until received by the health district.
