

RESOLUTION NO. 250

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County Roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution adopted on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962 said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on Crestview Drive Road #2090 beginning at a point 300 feet East of the intersection of the Agate Loop Road #2350 and running thence Westerly to Shorecrest Drive #2095 Plat of Shorecrest. Together with Shorecrest Drive #2095 from the intersection of Crestview Drive Road #2090 to the intersection of Parkway Blvd. #2011, Plat of Shorecrest, warrant speed limits of 35 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that said Crestview Drive #2090 beginning at a point 300 feet East of the intersection of the Agate Loop Road #2350 and running thence Westerly to Shorecrest Drive #2095 Plat of Shorecrest. Together with Shorecrest Drive #2095 from the intersection of Crestview Drive Road #2090 to the intersection of Parkway Blvd. #2011, Plat of Shorecrest be posted at 35 miles per hour and that the County Engineer be directed to erect the necessary 35 miles per hour signs in conformity herewith.
