

RESOLUTION NO. 254

WHEREAS, in accordance with House Bill No. 242, Chapter 124, 1st Extraordinary Session of 1971, which states that election officers shall be paid not less than the State minimum wage rate of \$1.60 per hour, which by Federal regulation has now been raised to \$1.90 per hour, with the exact amount to be fixed by the Board of County Commissioners of each County; and

WHEREAS, the Board's Resolution No. 174, adopted July 26, 1971, shall hereby be amended from the present \$1.60 per hour to \$2.00 per hour for Election Board workers, according to the new regulations adopted in 1972; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordered by the Board of Mason County Commissioners, that the County Auditor be hereby authorized to raise the pay of Election Officers to \$2.00 per hour, and that the inspector of each Board be paid two hours extra compensation, and the officer picking up and returning the election supplies be paid mileage at the rate of 10¢ per mile traveled in doing so.
