

RESOLUTION NO. 273

WHEREAS, County Road Project #756 involves minor widening of County Roads No. 7913 and 7967 on existing county right-of-way AND

WHEREAS, it develops that significant merchantable timber can be salvaged to the advantage of the County during the progress of the work AND

WHEREAS, the early and expeditious removal of the timber from the right-of-way is essential to the progress of the work under County Road Project #756;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an emergency exists and that the County Engineer be hereby authorized and directed to negotiate for the sale in incidental lots as produced in the course of the work under County Road Project #756;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds from the sales of such timber be deposited in the County Road Fund.
