

RESOLUTION NO. 277
ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on October 17, 1972, declaring that an unforeseen emergency had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the County Sheriff's budget for 1972; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND

County Sheriff - Category 521-11 (Extra Help) ----- \$600.00

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 2:00 P. M., Monday, October 30, 1972, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above extension in amount \$600.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
