

RESOLUTION NO. 278

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution adopted on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962 said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on the STRETCH ISLAND BRIDGE warrant speed limit of 20 miles per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said STRETCH ISLAND BRIDGE be posted at 20 miles per hour effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 20 mile per hour signs on said bridge in conformity herewith.
