

RESOLUTION NO. 281

WINTER ROAD RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, during the periods of freezing and thawing weather, such damage to County roads may be done by excessive loads on any vehicles which use the County roads; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the most expedient way to prevent this damage is to restrict the loads on vehicles;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days from December 11, 1972, vehicle loads on County roads may be restricted according to the following schedule:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these restrictions may be imposed or removed during said period of one hundred and twenty (120) days at the direction of the Board of County Commissioners or at the direction of the County Engineer.
