

RESOLUTION NO. 288

WHEREAS, the Road Department is in urgent need of cold asphalt patch mix in order to continue maintenance of damaged road surfaces in the most expeditious manner; and

WHEREAS, the modification of the County's dryer mixing plant, in order to satisfy the requirements of the Olympic Air Pollution Control Authority, has been delayed by technical difficulties; and

WHEREAS, the material needed is needed at the Mason County Central Shop on John's Prairie; and

WHEREAS, there is only one active asphalt plant within a 25 mile radius, that being the plant of Pacific Sand & Gravel, some 4 miles west of the desired location; and

WHEREAS; a firm price has been quoted to the County Engineer for the furnishing of 350-400 tons of the required asphalt patch mix.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that an emergency exists because of necessity; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Engineer has been authorized to proceed with the purchase of the material required, at the quoted price of \$7.50 per ton.
