

RESOLUTION NO. 303

WHEREAS, an unforeseen and undebatable emergency has arisen in the following Emergency Services Budget for 1973 for which no budget was provided; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for such expenditure as follows:

OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES - \$440.00 to cover \$40.00 per month salary raise for the Clerk, effective February 1, 1973, resulting from the passage of the State Merit Salary Bill. (Half of this sum will be reimbursed by the State).

NOW, THEREFORE, a nondebatable emergency is hereby declared to exist for the above department in the 1973 Emergency Services Budget, and that the Current Expense Budget for Emergency Services remittances be extended in the amount of \$220.00 to cover the County's share of the budget extension; and

IT IS HEREBY UNANIMOUSLY ORDERED by the Board in session that the total amount of \$440.00 for the Emergency Services budget, and the amount of \$220.00 for the Current Expense budget be ordered and authorized to provide the necessary funds to cover the above emergency, in accordance with RCW 36.40.180.
