

RESOLUTION NO. 304
ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on February 20, 1973, declaring that an unforeseen emergency had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the Office of Emergency Services budget for 1973; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditure is necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet it:

Office of Emergency Services - \$300.00 for the purchase of a 1968 Chevrolet from the County Road Department (purchase price \$500.00 less \$200.00 allowed for the 1963 Ford now being utilized by the Office of Emergency Services, leaving a balance of \$300.00 to be paid to the County Road Fund).

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, March 5, 1973, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above extension in amount \$300.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
