

RESOLUTION NO. 336

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County Roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution adopted on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962 said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County Roads unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on Shelton Springs Road, County Road #5081, from the Shelton City Limits to State Highway #101, warrant speed limit of 35 miles per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said Shelton Springs Road, from the Shelton City Limits to State Highway #101, be posted at 35 miles per hour effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 35 miles per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.
