

RESOLUTION NO. 354
ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on the 15th day of October, 1973, declaring that an unforeseen emergency had arisen for which there was insufficient budget in the Mason County Garbage Disposal Budget for 1973; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

\$7,253.00 to cover Solid Waste Ground Study

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 1:30 P. M., Monday, October 29, 1973, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$7,253.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
