

RESOLUTION NO. 375

WHEREAS, a 0.60-mile section of County Road No. 5019, Northcliff Road, and a 0.15-mile section at the easterly end of County Road No. 5130, are in imminent need of general surface maintenance, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to apply to these sections of road at the earliest practicable date an overlay of asphaltic concrete approximately 0.10 inch in thickness, and

WHEREAS, the uncertainties of weather and the urgency of the work preclude competitive bidding procedures, and

WHEREAS, the contractor for County Road Project No. 780, Skokomish Valley Road and County Road Project No. 781, Lynch Road, now has in the immediate area and in operation the only asphalt plant and paving equipment in the locality, and

WHEREAS, said contractor, Interstate Asphalt Company, has proposed to accomplish the work herein outlined on County Road No. 5019 and County Road No. 5130 at the same unit prices as bid under the contract for County Road Projects Nos. 780 and 781.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the aforementioned work on County Road Project No. 5019 and County Road Project No. 5130 as hereinbefore outlined.
