

RESOLUTION NO. 381

WHEREAS, in accordance with the recommendations of the Mason County Solid Waste Advisory Committee, in conformity with provisions of (provisional) PERMIT issued by Thurston-Mason Health District, and in accordance with an agreement with the City of Shelton, Mason County did on February 1, 1974 initiate the operation of a Solid Waste Disposal Landfill in the N $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4, Township 20 North, Range 4 West, W. M., and

WHEREAS, all solid waste formerly deposited at the former City of Shelton Disposal Site must now be and now is being accommodated at the new site, aforementioned, and

WHEREAS, the planned closure and/or relocation of other disposal sites in Mason County, particularly the imminent mandated closure of all burning dumps, will greatly increase the financial burden on Mason County for Solid Waste Disposal far beyond the limit of available tax revenue for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in order to defray in part this added cost for Solid Waste Disposal, a schedule of charges and the initial effective dates for all solid waste handled and disposed by Mason County is hereby adopted as set forth in the following Table of Charges:
