

RESOLUTION NO. 387

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on February 27, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the 1974 E. E. A. Program; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

County's share of E.E.A. Program for four employees - \$6,275.00  
(To finish up program, ending March 15, 1974)

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 2:15 P. M., Monday, March 11, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$6,275.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
